The THIRD ANNUAL FIREWORKS SHOW was held on Saturday August 3, 2019 at Chandos Beach. What a spectacular show it was!!!!! Once again an extremely well attended event, with spectators at the west end of the beach, the boat launch, in cottages in close proximity to the beach (Steve Tucker probably set a record of 90 people at his cottage) and about 230 boats south of the beach, with boaters singing and enjoying the ambience. We were once again fortunate to have ideal weather conditions for the evening. The event was not only for the cottagers but also residents of North Kawartha. This is the CLPOA most attended event with the President, David Cooper estimating some 3000 spectators.

The show was staged by a Montreal based pyrotechnical company, BEM which sent 2 pyrotechnicians for the third time, David and Gaston who started the setup of fireworks at 1:30. Beach goers were most co-operative. respecting the safe perimeter that was established for the event. The show lasted about 15 minutes with no end to the variety of fireworks, especially toward the end when fireworks were launched into the water which looked like duds when in fact after several seconds the fireworks shot upwards from the water.

We realize that the show is noisy and impacts the environment and cottagers. However, with one major show on the lake for the enjoyment of all, CLPOA is continually encouraging cottagers to cancel private fireworks and instead consider donating the money saved from not staging a private show to the CLPOA to help offset the cost of the show. In fact, we have had a number of cottagers informing us that they donated to CLPOA for this very reason. There have been discussions about silent fireworks at our Board meetings and the pros and cons will be reviewed at a future Board meeting.
